Which animals would have been reared and how would they serve people, other than as food?



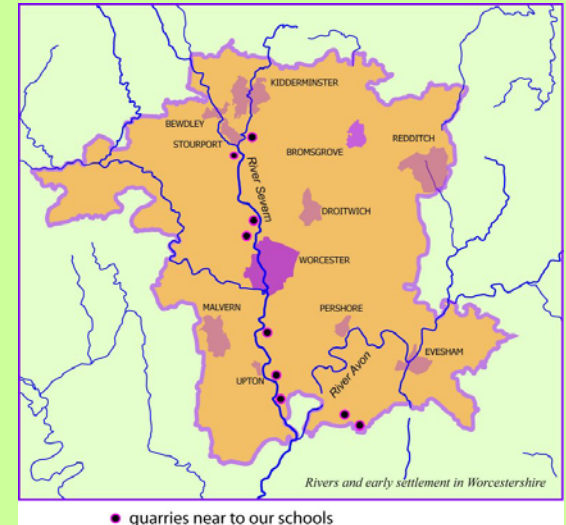
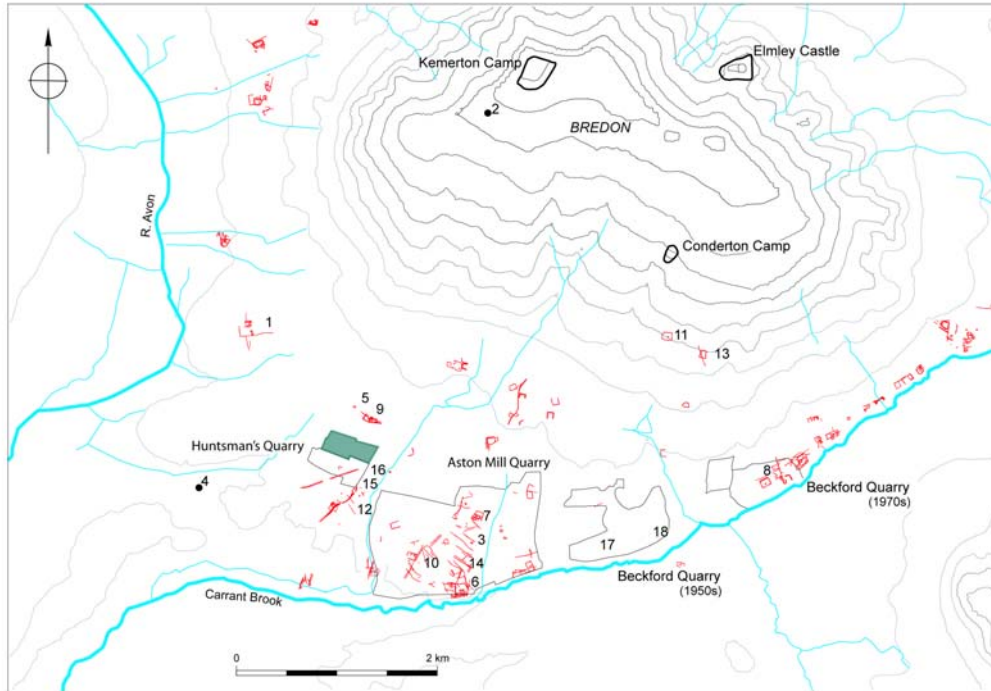
