Kidderminster St Mary's Militia 1824-1831

Worcestershire Record Office holds 3 printed volumes detailing the names taken for the militia between the ages of 18 and 45 at St Mary's, Kidderminster, 1824-1831 (reference number 850 BA4766/7).

The earliest book lists the names taken for the Militia between the age of 18 and 45 years on October 22nd 1824. This list has names taken by area and so has the benefit of showing where people were living. The later books (1825 -1831) list them alphabetically in blocks according to their surname, but each block is not truly alphabetical. However because there are not many names in each block this is not a major problem to a researcher. However there are notes in rough form, years 1825 and 1827, which have also been transcribed where it may be possible to determine where people were residing.

The years 1829 and 1830 do not appear to have been recorded. Further information was collected on their eligibility for the Militia including the number of children under fourteen.

Thanks to the hard work of Peter Brown and Ruth Butler, who have transcribed these documents, the information contained within is now available online.

The following pages show the transcriptions; in addition there is an appendix with the 1824 list sorted alphabetically.

Many forenames in the original document are abbreviated but there is no consistency, therefore they have been extended. Examples are Benjⁿ, Will^m, Tho^s, Cha^s, Hen^y, Edw^d for Benjamin, William, Thomas, Charles, Henry and Edward respectively.

Where there is an entry in square brackets [], it denotes that the writing in the original document was difficult to decipher and/or an interpretation of that writing has been entered. Although great care has been taken with the transcription, including the archaic spelling in the original documents, the authors do not guarantee its accuracy. Researchers are recommended to refer to the originals to satisfy themselves on the validity of an entry.
