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Introduction

The Valuation Office Survey of 1910 resulted in the creation of a snapshot of land across the county of Worcestershire, in common with other counties in England. The associated Valuation Summary books are to be found at the Hive in Worcester: these books are of a large format, measuring 43cm by 34cm, cloth-bound with leather corners and the name of the Income Tax Parish (ITP) written on the spine. An ITP may cover just a single civil parish in the county, whilst some ITPs covered two or more parishes: for example, the ITP of Church Lench only contains records for the civil parish of Church Lench, whilst that of Abbots Lench covers the civil parishes of Fladbury, Hill & Moor, Throckmorton and Wyre Piddle, as well as Abbots Lench itself. In some cases, two or more ITPs can be found in the same Valuation Summary book: for example, Conderton and Overbury. The basic unit of valuation was a piece of land in separate occupation, although the application of this principle was not always straightforward.¹ The number of valuation assessments in each ITP ranges across the county from 1 (Crutch) to 7,171 (Kidderminster Borough).

This series of booklets provides a transcription of the Valuation Summary books for each civil parish in the county of Worcestershire, along with a brief analysis of the transcribed data.

1. The Valuation Office Survey of 1910

The valuation of land in 1910 was initiated by the Finance (1909-1910) Act (10 Edw. VII, c.8 section 26(1)) which provided for the levy and collection of a duty on the increment value of all land in the United Kingdom. The main object of the Act was to tax that part of the capital appreciation of real property which was attributable to the site itself, excluding any benefit arising from crops, buildings or improvements paid for by the owners. In this way, private owners were required to pay part of the increase in the site value of their land which had resulted from the expenditure of public money on communal developments such as roads or public services.

Increment value duty was based on the difference between the amount of two valuations. The first was the site value as at 30 April 1909, as determined by the Valuation Survey, which constituted the 'datum line' for these purposes: a second site valuation was to be taken on the occasion of any subsequent sale or grant of a lease, transfer of interest in a piece of land, or the subsequent death of a land owner, in order to determine any potential payment of increment value duty. This second assessment formed part of the on-going role of the Valuation Office, until this duty was repealed by the 1920 Finance Act (10 and 11 Geo. V, c.18). Although this legislation was only in place for around ten years, it has left behind a comprehensive record of land in every county enabling an understanding of the ownership, occupation, extent and value of land. The data collected during the survey for the county of Worcestershire, which has been retained, is contained in four different sets:

- The Valuation Summary books (sometimes referred to as the Lloyd George Domesday books): these are held at the Hive in Worcester (WAAS: BA8585/1 series);
- Forms 37 – Land: these contain the provisional valuations, and are also held at the Hive in Worcester (WAAS: 8585/2-64 series);
- Two series of annotated Ordnance Survey maps: the Field Maps (used in the field during survey), some of which are now held at the Hive in Worcester; the Record Maps (originally

kept in the Valuation Record office) now held at the National Archives at Kew (TNA: IR129 series);

- The Field Books which contain a complete record of each valuation: again, these are held at the National Archives at Kew (TNA: IR58 series).

With regard to the Valuation Summary books, the first nine columns were compiled from the Rate Book for the parish and all of the books contain this information. Subsequent columns (10-40) were supposed to be completed by the staff of the District Valuation Offices after the initial valuation was complete: however, this was not carried out in a consistent fashion, and indeed, anyone interested in the mechanics and outcome of an individual valuation would be better served by the details contained in the Field Books.

This series of booklets provides a transcription of the first nine columns in that these record the ownership, occupation, extent, and basic valuation of each assessment. After a brief introduction to the parish, an analysis of the data will be presented examining the names of the major landowners and the extent of their property in the parish, along with an analysis of the main farms in the parish. Indexes of owners, occupiers and places appear in subsequent appendices and a final appendix will direct the reader to the appropriate references for the associated Forms 37, Record Maps and Field Books for the parish covered by the booklet.

This booklet presents the data for the civil parish of Charlton: it has been taken from the summary book for the Income Tax Parish of Charlton which covers the civil parishes of Charlton, Cropthorne, and Netherton.²

2. The parish of Charlton in 1910

The parish is located 4 miles east of Pershore and 3 miles north-west of Evesham on a geology described as a mixture of three mudstones ‘Mercia Mudstone Group’, ‘Saltford Shale Member’, and ‘Wilmcote Limestone Member’, extending to 1,582 acres. The resulting soils are a mixture of freely-draining, slightly-acid loamy soils, slightly-acid loamy & clayey soils with impeded drainage, and lime-rich loamy & clayey soils with impeded drainage.³

When the census was carried out in 1911, the population of Charlton was 471 (265 males and 207 females): of the 113 properties recorded in the census, 104 were inhabited, three were uninhabited, and six were classed as a ‘building not used as dwelling’.⁴ From an agricultural viewpoint in the same year, the total cultivated area of the parish was 1,592½ acres, of which 841¼ were arable, and 751¼ acres (47% of the total) were grassland: the acreage included 225¾ acres of orchards. Of the 69 agricultural holdings in the parish, 66 were tenanted properties covering 1,065¼ acres (67% of the total). The main arable crops were soft fruit, beans, cabbage, peas, and wheat, whilst the orchards were growing a range of top fruit. With less pasture land than arable, 98 cattle and 320 sheep were kept.⁵

3. Land and property in 1910 in the parish of Charlton

In preparing the data for analysis, a series of standardisations have been made: see Appendix 7 for full details.

Of the 167 assessments with owners recorded in the Valuation Summary, 92 were owned by James Faulkner J. P. of Charlton House: the other major landowner was George Swift who was a fruit merchant living in Offenham, having moved from Timperley in Cheshire.⁶ Between them, these two individuals also held the majority of the acreage in the parish.

Appendix 1. Transcribed data from the Valuation Summary for the parish of Charlton.

NOTES:

1. The tables in this appendix contain the data as transcribed from the Valuation Summary: however, index cross-referencing should refer to Appendix 2.
2. This data has been transcribed as presented in the Valuation Summary without any standardisation of punctuation, abbreviation &c. However, all data presented as superscripts has been included as normal text in this transcription.
3. An additional column of numeration was added to this Valuation Summary book before the 'No. of Assessment' column: this was headed I.T.A. on the first page and possibly stands for Income Tax Assessment [number]. These numbers are shown in column A of Table 4.
4. For some entries, there is no value given in the 'No. of Assessment' column [shown as column B of Table 4]: rather there is a number [written in red ink] under the heading of 'Included in'. These numbers are shown in column C of Table 4 – for example, see the entry for I.T.A. number 5.
5. For some entries, there is a value given in the 'No. of Assessment' column, along with an added note in red ink stating 'Included in' followed by a number. These numbers are also shown in column C of Table 4 - for example, see the entry for I.T.A. number 43.
6. At the end of the Valuation Summary, there are a number of further I.T.A. references which summarise groups of I.T.A. references under common descriptions for 'Situation': these are presented in Table 5.

Appendix 7. Data standardisations made for the parish of Charlton

In preparing the data for analysis, the following standardisations have been made:

- Where entries appear in either owner names or occupier names, which use abbreviations or the full name, the listings in Appendices 3 and 4 show the full name for all variations: for example, for cases with the same surname only, where *Geo* and *George* appear, these are all recorded under *George*; however, those entries with only the initial *G.* are not assumed to be *George*;
- Using the above logic, then:
 - *Chas* and *Charles* are recorded as *Charles*;
 - *Ed* and *Edward* are recorded as *Edward*;
 - *Fk* and *Frederick* are recorded as *Frederick*;
 - *Hy* and *Henry* are recorded as *Henry*;
 - *Thos* and *Thomas* are recorded as *Thomas*;
 - *Wm* and *William* are recorded as *William*.
- Two variations of owner name, *F. D. Holland Exors* and *Exors of F. D. Holland d'd* are shown in Appendix 1: the listing in Appendix 3 shows *Holland, F. D., Exors.* for both of these variations;
- The owner name, *Evesham & Pershore S. P. H. Committee* shown in Appendix 1 has been standardised to *Evesham & Pershore Smallpox Hospital Committee* in the listing in Appendix 3;
- The owner name, *Great W. R. Co* shown in Appendix 1 has been standardised to *Great Western Railway Company* in the listing in Appendix 3;
- Two variations of occupier names, *W. R. Deakins & Co* and *W. R. Deakin & Co* are shown in Appendix 1: the listing in Appendix 4 shows *W. R. Deakin & Co* for both variations;
- Two variations of situation, *Bresmans Furlong* and *Bresman's Furlong* are shown in Appendix 1: the listing in Appendix 5 shows *Bresman's Furlong* for both of these variations;
- Two variations of situation, *Ridon* and *Riden* are shown in Appendix 1: the listing in Appendix 5 shows *Ridon* for both of these variations;
