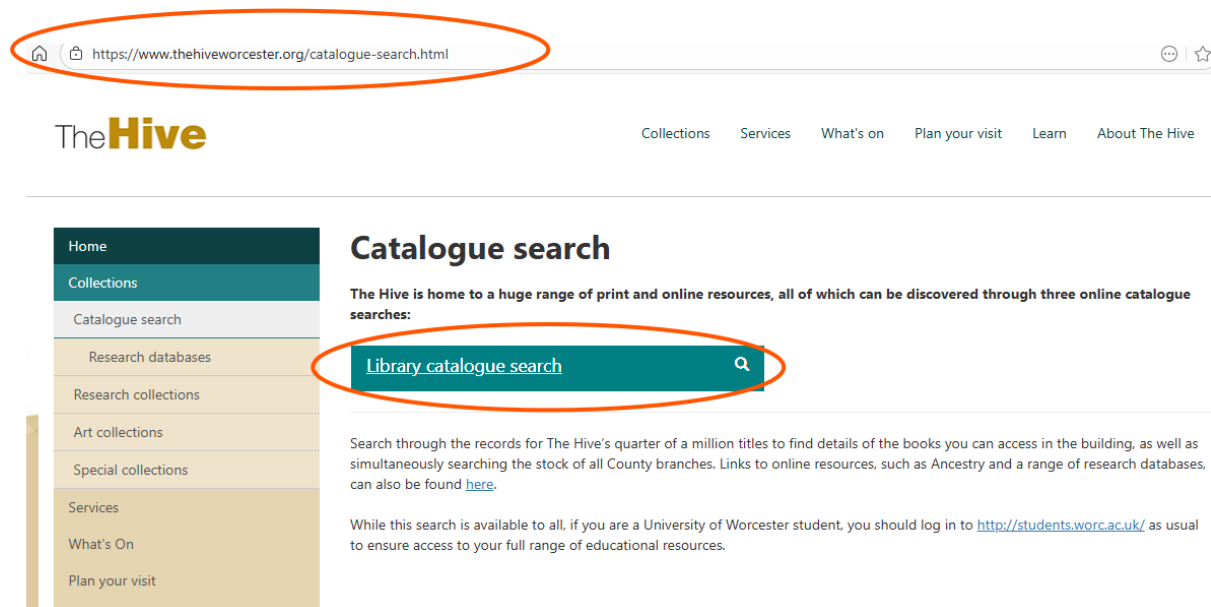


Searching for local history books on level 2 at The Hive

Use the designated computer on level 2 (with the white backing)

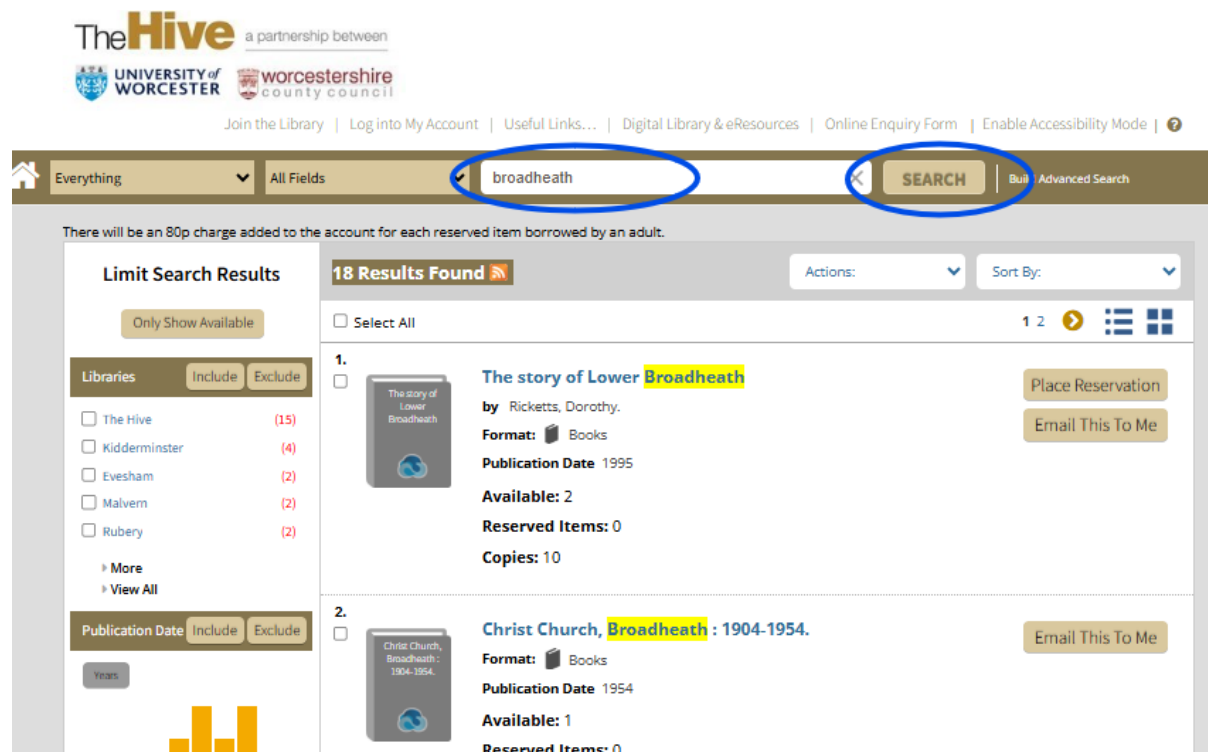
From home use an internet browser such as Google Chrome to find 'The Hive Library Worcester' website. The web address is:

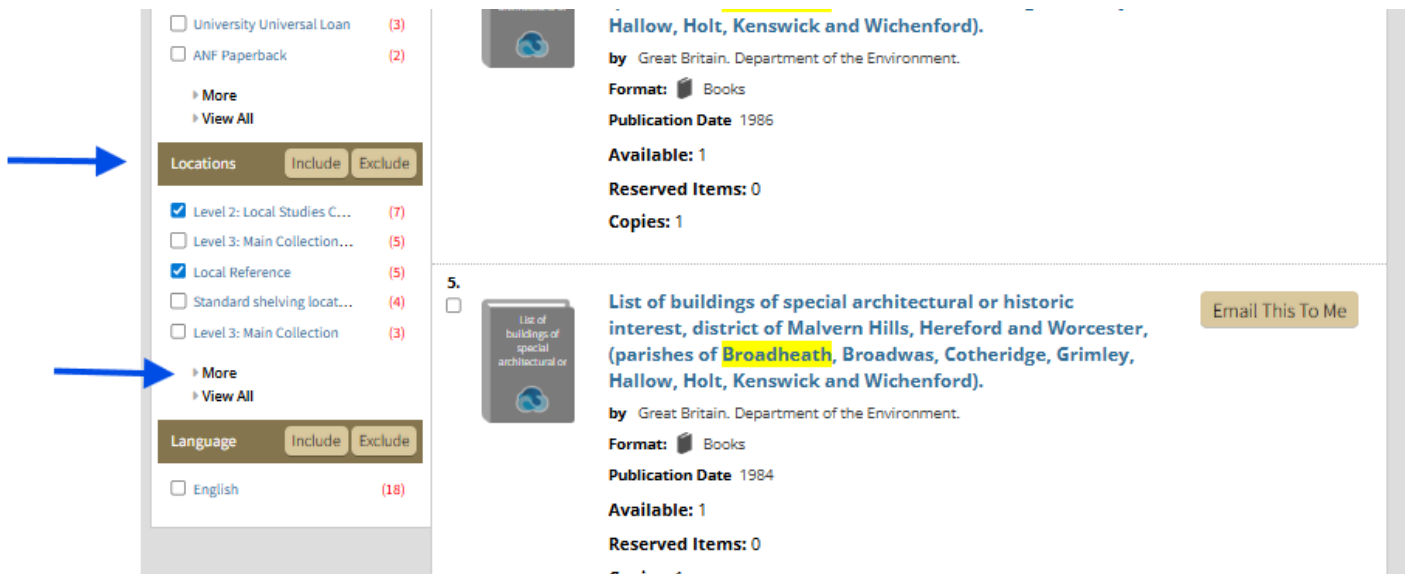
Click 'library catalogue search'

Once you have typed out a search term such as 'broadheath' and clicked 'search', a menu on the left will appear:

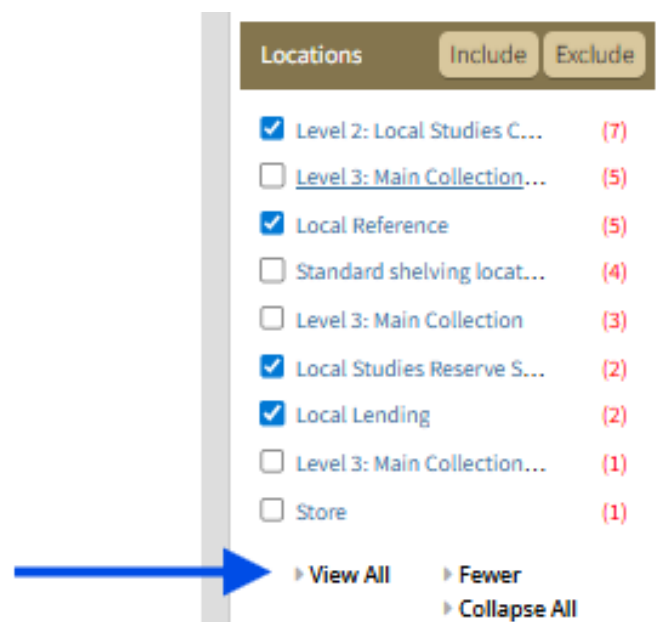


Searching for local history books on level 2 at The Hive
